Table 1 Additional costs related to school attendance in the school year 2025/2026.

1. Mandatory expenses

a. School books and school supplies:

i. Maximum in Primary 500€;

ii. Maximum in Secondary 750€.

b. School outings – Maximum 450€ per year depending on the number and type of outings planned.

c. Pool (Nursery to Primary 3) 350€ for a term. Number of terms will depend on age and pool availability.

d. School uniform - Maximum 250€.

At the exception of the school uniforms, **mandatory expenses** are a flat rate that will be invoiced once your application is accepted and **will have to be paid before April 20th** to confirm your place at the school.

2. Mandatory expenses - variable costs

a. School trips (with at least one night out):

i. Usually one trip per year. For orientation, school trips cost in school year 2023-24 were in a range from $250 \in$ to $1.000 \in$.

3. Optional expenses

a. School lunches - 1.750€ per year (5 days a week).

b. School buses – according to the invoice of the transport company. In 2024-2025 the transport fees varied from $2.750 \in$ to $4950 \in$ depending on pupil's domicile and the company used.

School lunch and buses **will be invoiced annually** and will have to be paid annually. Bus transport costs may be reimbursed by the PMO (or the relevant service of your institution) up to the maximum ceiling of the education allowance. Any amount exceeding this ceiling must be covered by the family.

d. Extra-curricular activities: in school year 2023-24 the costs ranged from $195 \in$ to $395 \in$ per day per term (3 terms per year) depending on the activity (cost of the teacher, needs of material, etc.). Individual music classes, maximum $1.500 \in$ annually for 30 minutes of individual music class.

Extra-curricular activities will be paid directly on the extra-curricular platform at the moment of inscription at the beginning of each term.

 Table 2 Additional fees regarding schooling of students with special needs.

1. General support and moderate support are included in the school tuition.

2. In case of intensive support: Parents will be asked to participate in the cost of the necessary accommodation (i.e. special arrangements to meet the pupil's needs) agreed in a convention signed between the school and the pupil's parents. The maximum cost for a full time assistant is 60.000 and maximum amount for one on one hourly session is 75.

3. In case of students subscribing to the school not having the Language, Maths or Science required level by the European Schools, extra classes that will be charged to the parents, at a cost of maximum 75€ per hour of such extra class.

Future possible expenses that will not apply in 2025-26

2.b. Additional justified educationally relevant costs:

i. Up to 650€ annually.

3. c. European workshop classes, which are an extension to the standard curriculum in P1-P2 and in S1-S3. Classes will take place at the beginning or the end of the day and there will be a childcare solution for students who take the bus and opt out of this optional class. The yearly cost is $650 \in$.

4. a. IT personal school computer program - Max 450€ per year.

These expenses do not apply to the 2025-26 school year but could be added in the future.

Notes on school fees:

Per the agreement, the School exempts pupils covered by a EU contribution agreement from school fees (included admission fees).

Parents whose EU institution contract stops during a school year and decide to keep their child enrolled will be invoiced for the remaining months based on monthly pro-rata of the EU contribution.

Parents will be liable for the full school fees if they wrongly applied as being covered by a contribution agreement.
